
# As a Signals Notebook Individual Edition User

- You can only export **NOTEBOOKS** and their content from Signals Notebook **Individual Edition**.
- Any **EXPERIMENT** outside of a **NOTEBOOK** needs to be moved into a **NOTEBOOK** for export.
- Exported **NOTEBOOKS** can only contain **up to 100 EXPERIMENTS**. If your **NOTEBOOKS** have **more than 100 EXPERIMENTS**, they will need to be broken down during the export process (Notebook-0-to-100, Notebook-101-to-200, Notebook-201-to-300 etc.)
- **EXPERIMENT** hyperlinks, user comments, and audit trail information from Signals Notebook **Individual Edition** will not be exported.
- You can only move NOTEBOOKS
  from https://chemdraweln.signalsresearch.revvitycloud.com towards a SNB Standard instance
  or
  from https://signalsresearch.revvitycloud.com/ towards a SNB Standard instance
- You **CANNOT move data** between https://chemdraweln.signalsresearch.revvitycloud.com and https://signalsresearch.revvitycloud.com/


## Log on to Signals Notebook Individual Edition

Repeat for every **NOTEBOOK** 




Note: if your Notebook contains more than 100 experiments, you will need to export it into multiple files.
